

## Pranpur

Ashok Nagar District, Madhya Pradesh

Pranpur is just 3 km from historic Chanderi, in the Betwa river basin, famous for delicately crafted 'tana-bana' gossamer thin silk and cotton saris. Visitors are encouraged to try their hands at the loom!

The experience is truly interactive...weaving, pottery, metalware...never far from the rustle of soft fabric. The spell continues at the 'Amraee' rural resort, created by traditional village masons.



When local folk artistes perform, the mood harkens to 11th century lore, replete with legends of the Bundela Rajputs, the Delhi and Malwa Sultans, the Moghuls and the Marathas.
